Our Hanse 342 makes sailing fast and easy with furler and halyards all led aft to the cockpit.



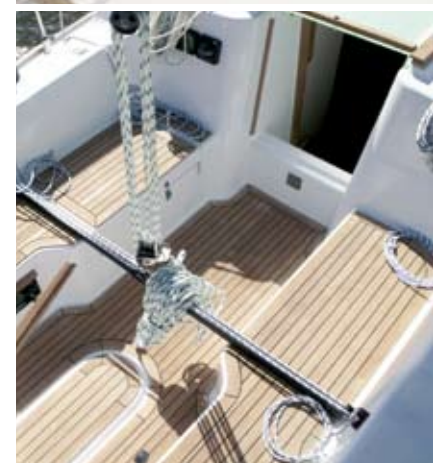
The hinged gangway astern next to the swimming ladder may become your favourite place.

The mainsheet traveller is located on the deckhouse and does not interfere in the cockpit.

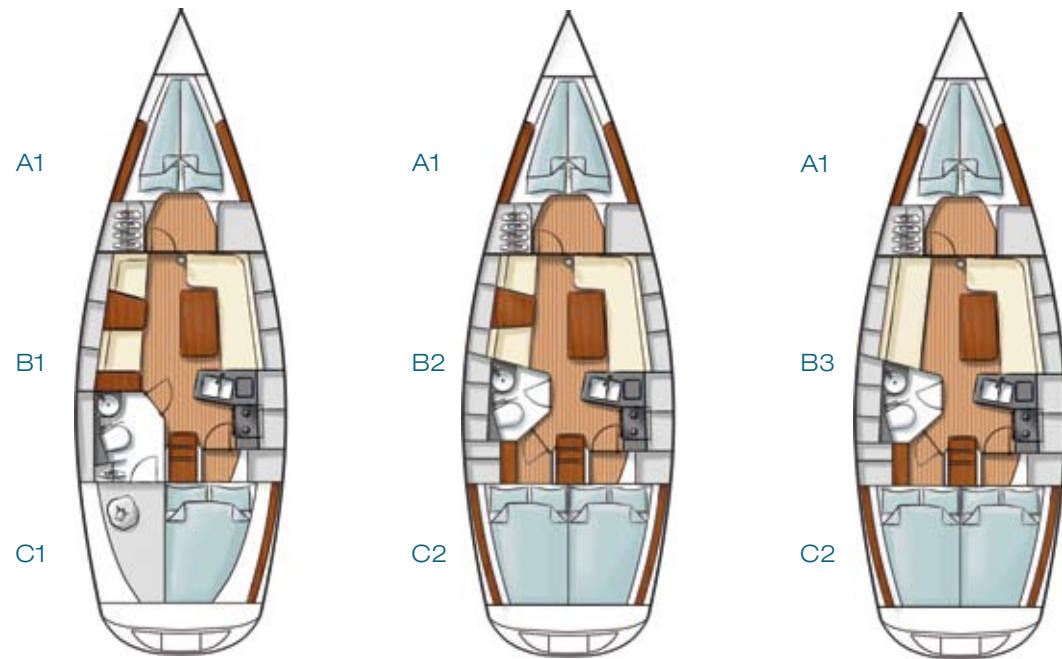


Some owners prefer the traveller within easy reach. We can also fulfill this wish with an optional cockpit traveller.

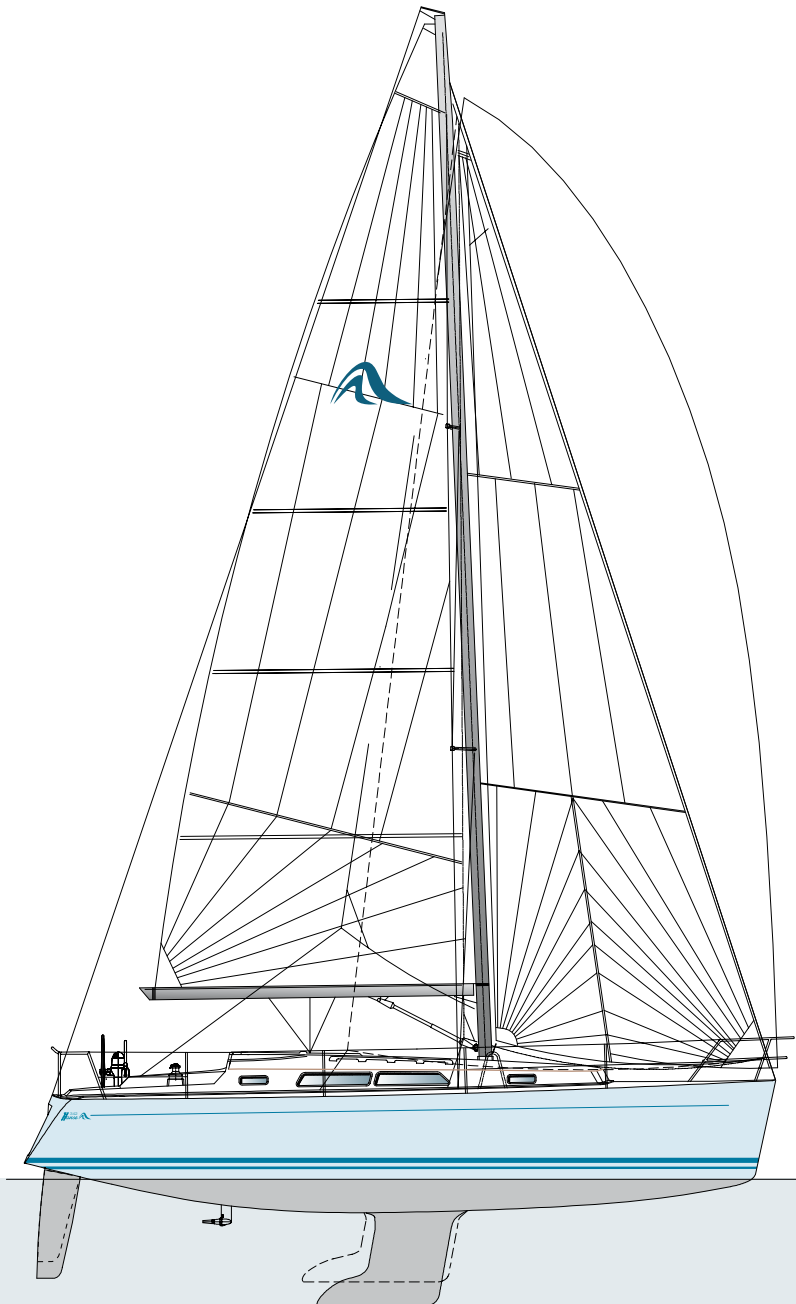
